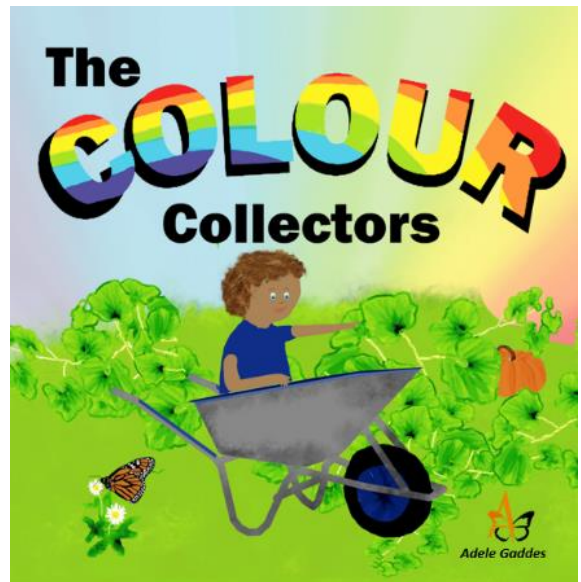
The new book
